(U) SITUATION: THE SURGEON GENERAL'S (TSG) ANNUAL AWARD FOR MILITARY ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE (THE LEWIS ASPEY MOLOGNE AWARD) PROVIDES PERSONAL RECOGNITION BY TSG TO AN ARMY PHYSICIAN FOR OUTSTANDING LEADERSHIP IN MILITARY/ACADEMIC MEDICINE. THIS PRESTIGIOUS AWARD IS SEPARATE AND DISTINCT FROM ANY OTHER AWARD THAT MAY BE GIVEN TO A PHYSICIAN FOR EXCEPTIONAL DUTY PERFORMANCE. THIS AWARD APPLIES TO ALL ARMY COMMANDS AND ORGANIZATIONS HAVING ACTIVE-DUTY PHYSICIANS ASSIGNED ON A FULL-TIME BASIS. RECIPIENTS WILL BE FUNDED TO RECEIVE THE AWARD AT THE JOINT GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION SELECTION BOARD.

(U) MISSION: NO LATER THAN 30 AUGUST 2024, UNITS HAVING PHYSICIANS ASSIGNED ON A FULL-TIME BASIS WILL NOMINATE ARMY ACTIVE DUTY PHYSICIANS FOR THE LEWIS ASPEY MOLOGNE AWARD FOR CALENDAR YEAR (CY) 2024. IN SEPTEMBER 2024, THE 20TH ARMY MEDICAL CORPS (MC) CHIEF WILL CONVENE A SELECTION BOARD OF SENIOR MC PHYSICIANS WHO WILL GENERATE AN ORDER OF MERIT LIST (OML) RECOMMENDATION TO THE MC CHIEF. THE MC CHIEF WILL SEND THE TOP NOMINEE'S NAME AND THE OML TO TSG FOR DECISION/APPROVAL NO LATER THAN 30 SEPTEMBER 2024.
- 4. (U) EXECUTION:

- 4.A. (U) ELIGIBILITY/SELECTION CRITERIA.
- 4.A.1. (U) MC OFFICERS ON ACTIVE DUTY IN THE GRADE OF COLONEL ARE ELIGIBLE. OFFICERS IN THE GRADE OF LTC(P) ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. GENERAL OFFICERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.
- 4.A.2. (U) INDIVIDUALS NOMINATED SHOULD EXHIBIT A BALANCE BETWEEN LEADERSHIP IN MILITARY MEDICINE AND TEACHING.
- 4.A.3. (U) NOMINEES SHOULD HAVE DEMONSTRATED ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE THROUGH THE FOLLOWING: 1-SERVICE AS RESIDENCY TRAINING PROGRAM DIRECTOR; 2-PARTICIPATION IN RESEARCH AS EVIDENCED BY SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATIONS; AND 3-HOLDING OFFICE IN NATIONAL OR INTERNATIONAL PROFESSIONAL SOCIETIES.
- 4.A.4. (U) PRIOR AWARD RECIPIENTS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.
- 4.A.5. (U) NOMINEE MUST HAVE AT LEAST ONE YEAR OF SERVICE REMAINING AT THE TIME OF NOMINATION.
- 4.B. (U) RESPONSIBILITIES:
- 4.B.1. (U) TSG IS THE AWARDING AUTHORITY.
- 4.B.2. (U) COMMANDERS AT ALL LEVELS WILL IDENTIFY POTENTIAL RECIPIENTS AND SUBMIT NOMINATIONS ACCORDINGLY. STAFF SURGEONS AT ALL MAJOR AND SUBORDINATE NON-MEDICAL COMMAND HEADQUARTERS WILL ASSIST COMMANDERS IN THIS REGARD. WITH CONCURRENCE OF THESE COMMANDERS, NOMINATIONS MAY BE SUBMITTED BY STAFF SURGEONS. COMMANDERS WILL PUBLICIZE THE AWARD AND ITS RECIPIENT WHEN ANNOUNCED, EMPHASIZING DUTY PERFORMANCE AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO MILITARY MEDICINE (WITHIN SECURITY AND PRIVACY ACT REQUIREMENTS).

(U) A COMPLETE NOMINATION PACKET WILL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS, IN ORDER, IN A SINGLE PDF FILE, (DO NOT SEND AS A PORTFOLIO): 1-NOMINATION MEMORANDUM; 2-COMMANDER'S ENDORSEMENT (IF NOMINATED BY A STAFF SURGEON, ANY LEVEL COMMANDER MAY ENDORSE); 3-NARRATIVE SUMMARY; 4-CURRICULUM VITAE; AND 5-REDACTED SOLDIER TALENT PROFILE WITHOUT DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY PHOTO, GENDER, RACE, ETHNICITY, RELIGION, OR MARITAL STATUS.

- 4.C.1.C. (U) INCLUSIVE DATES OF RECOMMENDATION. GENERALLY, NOMINATIONS WILL BE MADE FOR DUTY PERFORMANCE IN CY 2023.
