IISE OF THE TERM "CONTINENTAL ARMY COMMANDER"

- 1. Effective immediately, the term "Continental Army Commander" will be used only with reference to the Commanding General, Continental Army Command. It will not be used to refer to commanding generals of the numbered armies in the Continental United States.
- 2. The collective term "ZI army commanders" will be used when referring to commanding generals of the six numbered armies in the United States. When referring to a particular commander or command, current designations, such as "Commanding General, First Army" and "Headquarters, First Army," will continue to be used.
