I. U.S. ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND SECURITY LIAISON UNIT, FORT HOLABIRD, MARYLAND. *Effective 1 July 1965*, the U.S. Army Materiel Command Security Liaison Unit, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is discontinued. Concurrently, its functions, personnel, and funds are transferred to the Commanding General, U.S. Army Intelligence Command, Fort Holabird, Maryland.

II. ROTC UNITS AT MILITARY SCHOOLS. In accordance with paragraph 9c(2), AR 145-25. ROTC units at the following named essentially military schools are designated as honor ROTC units for the school year 1964-65. IV--ROTC UNIT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI AT ROLLA, ROLLA, MISSOURI. *Effective the beginning of the 1965-66 school year, the Engineer Branch Material ROTC unit at the University of Missouri at Rolla, Rolla, Missouri, is converted to a General Military Science ROTC unit.*

V--ROTC UNIT AT ROSE POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE, TERRE HAUTE, INDIANA. *Effective the beginning of the 1965-66 school year, the Engineer Branch Material ROTC unit at Rose Polytechnic Institute, Terre Haute, Indiana, is converted to a General Military Science ROTC unit.*
